**WALTER J. MOLOFSKY, M.D., CHIEF OF PEDIATRIC
NEUROLOGY AT BETH ISRAEL MEDICAL CENTER TO BE HONORED
AT THE NEEDLERS FOUNDATION'S ANNUAL GALA**

Molofsky, M.D., Chief of Pediatric Neurology at Beth Israel Medical Center and founding member of the Hyman-Newman Institute of Neurology and Neurosurgery (INN) at Roosevelt Hospital, will be honored at The Needlers Foundation's annual Gala scheduled for Wednesday, June 16, 2010 at Gotham Hall in New York City.

Dr. Molofsky has a special interest in the treatment of neurovascular disorders, headaches, epilepsy, peripheral nerve problems, cerebral palsy, and neuro-developmental problems in infants and children. He is a fellow with the American Academy of Neurology and the Child Neurology Society and has been named every year since 1995 in Castle Connolly's "Top Doctors – New York Metro Area," recognized as one of the outstanding pediatric neurologists in the country.
